Wartburg's New Memory Care Center Opens in Mount Vernon

Mount Vernon, NY – May 2, 2024 – Wartburg is excited to announce The Berkemeier Center, a 50,500 square-foot facility dedicated to Alzheimer's Disease and Related Dementia care is now open and accepting patients.

The new Memory Care Center features 64 state-of-the-art residences, including 32 private and 32 companion suites, focused on Alzheimer's and dementia care. Wartburg's leadership, design team, business and civic leaders, and the media will attend the ribbon cutting, followed by facility tours. Residences at The Living Center are designed like small households, creating an intimate and comfortable feel. Key features like short walking distances and oversized windows enhance the healing environment, with each household having its living, dining, and kitchen spaces.

The first-floor lobby and gallery showcase Wartburg's history, featuring artifacts from the 158 year history. Additionally, the first level includes event spaces, a music therapy room, and administrative offices. A healing garden in the rear yard provides outdoor seating and community space. The Living Center benefits from nearby nursing and rehabilitation centers on campus. It is LEED-certified, reflecting its energy efficiency and health-conscious design.

The Living Center is named in honor of Wartburg's second President, Reverend Dr. Gottlieb C. Berkemeier, who served for thirty-six years and elevated The Wartburg Orphans' Farm School to a leading institution.

The community came out in force for the Grand Opening on April 30, 2024.

I also want to recognize the Board of directors, who supported this effort through concept, entitlement approval, design, financing, and construction.
