

**The Osborn Pavilion Honored as a “2025 Best Nursing Home” by
U.S. News & World Report
-Recognized for both Short-Term Rehabilitation and Long-Term Care-**

Rye, NY, November 21, 2024: The Osborn Pavilion in Rye has been recognized as a “Best Nursing Home” for 2025 by *U.S. News & World Report*, receiving a 5/5 overall rating. It is one of only four skilled nursing facilities in Westchester County to achieve a High Performing rating in both the Short-Term Rehabilitation and Long-Term Care categories.

To be recognized as one of the 2025 U.S. News Best Nursing Homes, a home must have been “High Performing” in short-term rehabilitation, long-term care, or both. The Osborn Pavilion achieved “High Performing” in both short-term rehabilitation and long-term care, one of only 643 nursing facilities in the United States to achieve “High Performing” in both categories which equals just 4.3% of all the nursing homes in the country.

“We are very proud that The Osborn Pavilion has once again been recognized by *U.S. News & World Report* as one of the best nursing homes in the country for both short-term rehabilitation and long-term care,” said Matthew G. Anderson, President and CEO of The Osborn. “This honor reflects the outstanding expertise and dedication of our staff, who provide the highest quality of care to our residents and a deep sense of security to our families.”

The *U.S. News Best Nursing Homes* ratings were determined by nurse staffing, patient outcomes, and whether steps known to be effective in avoiding harm and improving health were built into nursing home routines. The Short-Term Rehabilitation rating is based on *U.S. News’s* assessment of 9 quality measures focusing on nurse staffing, patient outcomes, facility deficiencies, and processes of care. The Long-Term Care rating is based on assessment of 8 quality measures focusing on nurse staffing, patient outcomes, and turnover of ownership and staff. *U.S. News* used scientific literature review, discussions with industry experts, and statistical modeling to select these measures.
