

Grant opportunity for LTC facilities

The Joint Commission and Pfizer Medical Education Group (PMEG) are collaborating in a Request for Proposals (RFP) to accelerate the development and adoption of evidence-based approaches that have the capacity to prevent or contain Antimicrobial Resistance (AMR), and that support and promote appropriate use of antimicrobial agents. Grants will support the development, testing, and implementation of sustainable antimicrobial stewardship strategies and programs that can be shown to contain and prevent AMR in acute care hospitals (academic medical centers and community-based hospitals), long term care facilities, ambulatory care facilities and other out-patient settings.

This RFP is being issued by both The Joint Commission and PMEG; The Joint Commission will lead the application evaluation process and oversee a proposal review committee that will make the funding decisions.
